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Sc001 Constellation Chart Part 1: the sc001 constellation chart imaging the universe, the sc001 is useful for showing the coordinates and names of a large number of stars it can be used by itself in learning the constellations, although it is not quite as convenient as the star wheel the sc001 chart only goes up to a declination of 60 degrees.

Navigating the Night Sky

The Horizon and Visible Stars. ?The southernmost stars you can see must have a declination greater than – (90o - l) ?For us: - (90o – 40o) = - 50o. ?So we can never see the “Southern Cross” constellation Crux, because it has a declination of - 60o and is always below our horizon.

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One of the most useful is the “SC001” chart. This map covers the equatorial region of the celestial sphere. The north and south polar regions are represented in SC002 and SC003 charts, respectively. These charts are confusing at first glance, as there is no horizon or “landmarks” with which to orient yourself.

SC001: p. 1

sc001 The SC001 star map (produced by Sky Publishing) is a projection of the celestial sphere onto a flat sheet of paper. It includes about 85% of the celestial sphere, excluding only the regions near the north and south celestial poles .

The chart above shows the division of the night sky into 88 constellations, plotted on a rectangular grid right ascension – celestial longitude – and declination – celestial latitude. Two color schemes are available: light-on-dark, recommended for screen viewing, or dark-on-light which is printer friendly.
